Marco Pasqua is a dynamic force in accessibility, entrepreneurship, and advocacy. Born with Cerebral Palsy, he has spent his life proving that obstacles are just opportunities in disguise. An award-winning entrepreneur, accessibility consultant, and best-selling author, Marco's journey is fueled by resilience, creativity, and an unwavering belief in the power of human connection.

His public speaking career began at just 10 years old, where he discovered the profound impact of storytelling. Since then, he has become a powerful voice for disability advocacy across Canada, working as a spokesperson for numerous organizations and demonstrating that meaningful change starts with the right energy and mindset.

Marco initially pursued a career in technology, earning his credentials from the Art Institute of Vancouver before spending five years in the video game industry. But when the 2010 recession cost him his job, he saw it as the turning point he didn't know he needed. Instead of playing it safe, he doubled down on his passion for speaking, launching his own brand as a thought leader in accessibility and social impact.

As an entrepreneur, Marco has helped businesses, municipalities, and organizations across multiple industries create more inclusive workplaces, both in their employment strategies and built environments. He has collaborated with the Rick Hansen Foundation, The Presidents Group (accessibleemployers.ca), HireForTalent.ca, and the Province of British Columbia's employment advisory committee, advocating for universal design, workplace inclusion, and accessibility improvements in physical spaces.

His speaking engagements have taken him to some of the most respected stages, including TEDxStanleyPark, The Duke of Edinburgh Awards, and as emcee of the Accessibility Professionals Networking Conference (APN) since its inception. His impact has earned him prestigious accolades, including being named "Entrepreneur of the Year" by the Self-Employment and Entrepreneur Development Society and being recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow by Rotary International.

Marco believes that success isn't measured by financial transactions—it's built through human interactions. Through his work, he continues to challenge perceptions, break barriers, and inspire audiences to rethink what's possible when accessibility and inclusion are prioritized.
